

# Long Term Conditions Fellowship

An exciting learning and practice development opportunity will be available from January 2017 for health and social care practitioners to undertake a Long Term Conditions Fellowship, consisting of a 20 credit module (levels 6 or 7, or attendance only) at the University of East Anglia, combined with a work based learning portfolio and practice based experience.

The aims of the Fellowship are to provide a learning experience which enhances participants' knowledge and experience in working with patients living with long term conditions.

## Time Commitment

- Applicants will need to secure employer agreement to be released from practice for six face to face study days for the Long Term Conditions module, two preparatory Study Days looking at Critical thinking and advanced critical thinking to be held at UEA Norwich and portfolio workshops to be delivered across Norfolk & Suffolk.
- In addition applicants will be expected to undertake a super-numeracy placement.
- The Modules will cover: Diabetes/Cardio Vascular/Falls/ Dementia

## Financial Support

- Course fees for the educational element will be fully funded by Health Education England.

## Entry Criteria:

- Two years post registration experience or equivalent.
- You will need approval from your line manager and Educational Lead if appropriate.
- Funding available to health and social care practitioners of any profession, working in Norfolk, Suffolk or North East Essex.
