### Are you, as a Nurse or Midwife, prepared for revalidation?

The Norfolk and Suffolk Workforce Partnership is running six workshops to help support you with the revalidation process and answer your questions.

### What is revalidation?

NMC Revalidation is a process being introduced by the NMC that all nurses and midwives will be required to undertake every three years, in order to renew their registration. In order to remain on the register, you will need to engage with the process to demonstrate that you keep up to date, and practise safely and effectively.

### What will the workshops involve?

Our workshops, led by **Ruth Burey, Facilitator of Professional Learning & Development with the RCN and Tracey Risebrow, Clinical Practice Facilitator at Ipswich Hospital**, will:

- explore what revalidation is and how the changes will affect you
- explain what you need to do to prepare for NMC revalidation
- help you to understand the role of the confirmer
- offer practice in writing a reflective practice account and signpost you to useful resources
